REMINDERS

The following reminders are made necessary because The Board recently was notified of the following violations of two of our long standing rules. Both were verified ;

- No one regardless of age that wears or needs to wear diapers of any kind is allowed to be in either of our pools or Spa—this is both an Association rule and a County Health Department rule.
- Besides potential fines any resident associated with this violation could face hundreds of dollars of costs to pay to remediate the water by professionals if we "flunk" the weekly mandated laboratory water testing, directly after the incident.
- No one under 19 years of age is allowed to ever use our billiard table in the clubhouse lounge. This is one of the VFP Billiard rules posted on sign on the bar in lounge.

REPORTING AN ISSUE AT THE VILLAS AT FIVE PONDS

There appears to be some confusion regarding how to report any issue at The Villas at Five Ponds that affects you.

To date, there have been emails, phone messages or contacting a Board member(s) when a resident has an issue, whether it be landscaping, snow clean up, something not working properly in the clubhouse, etc. Inevitably, the issue must go through Continental Management, Amy Wert so that she may track it through resolution. The issue gets quicker attention if you follow the streamlined process that has been established which is as follows:

On the VFP Website, within the Residents Only section, there is a link — "*Report an issue or submit a request to Continental Property Management—Click HERE.*" Please utilize the link and fill out the form which asks for your name, address, email, phone number and a description of the issue. In addition, there is a link where you may upload a picture. When the form is completed, it is automatically routed to Amy so that she may get in touch with the appropriate party/vendor as well as track it through its resolution.

As an example, recently a resident had a landscaping issue. Initially the resident contacted a Board Member who then contacted Amy. The resident was copied on the correspondence. Amy then contacted Total Turf and replied to the Board Member and the resident that Total Turf was notified. Additionally, the resident contacted a second Board Member and reported that no one responded with an update. The second Board member let the Board know and the first Board member replied that the issue had already been reported to Continental Management. Meanwhile, Total Turf resolved the issue in less than 24 hours of the initial report. If the resident had utilized the link on the website, none of the back and forth would have occurred.

Granted that not every issue is resolved that quickly. Total Turf was on the premises and was able to take care of it very quickly.

Other issues may take longer. As an example, there have been many landscaping requests recently regarding dead trees and either the ask for a replacement tree or a request to just plant grass. Total Turf is notified by Amy, and they then go to the location of the tree to evaluate whether the tree is dead, what it will take to remove the tree and the stump and what the cost is for the replacement of the tree. At the monthly Board meeting, Amy reviews every request with an update from Total Turf including what the labor cost is of the removal of the tree and the stump, the cost of the new tree and the optimal time to plant. The Board then votes on each request. Upon approval, a Board member goes back to Total Turf and negotiates down the cost of all the work done at the time. So, while you are wondering what has happened, there is considerable back and

Book Reviews

“THE FROZEN RIVER”

BY ARIEL LAWHON ■ SHARYN POLSKY, BOOK REVIEWER

ARIEL LAWHON IS THE QUEEN of historical fiction. She is the critically acclaimed *New York Times* best-selling author of *The Wife*, *The Maid and the Mistress*, *Flight of Dreams*, *I Was Anastasia*, and *Code Name Helene*. Her books have been translated into over 30 languages and have been Library Reads, One Book One County, Indie Next, Costco, Book of the Month Club selections as well as Good Morning America selections.

The book is about 75% historically factual, the rest of the story is what could have happened. It was inspired by real events, not based on them. If you want to read the real story you should read *The Midwife's Tale: The Life of Margaret Ballard* by Laurel Thatcher Ulrich. It was based on her diary and won a Pulitzer Prize.

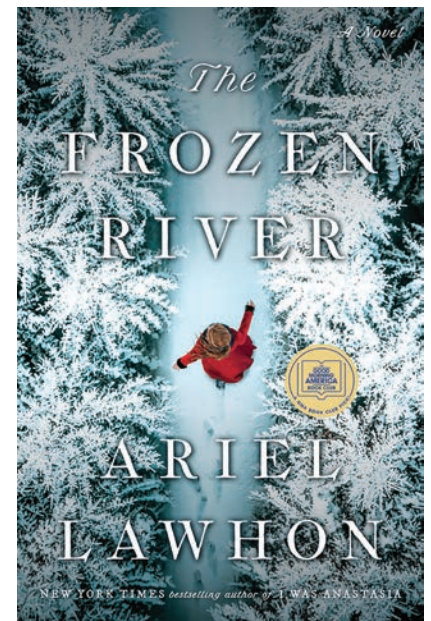
The story takes place in Hallowell, Maine in 1789 when the Kennebec River freezes entombing a man in the ice. Martha Ballard is summoned to examine the body and determine the cause of death. As a midwife and healer she is privy to what goes on behind closed doors.

Months earlier Martha documented the details in her diary, of an alleged rape committed by one of the town's most respected gentlemen, one of whom has been found dead in the ice. She believes the cause of death to be murder but she is opposed by a young Harvard-educated doctor who deems the death as accidental even though he has never examined a murder victim before.

Over the course of one winter, as the trial nears and gossip and prejudices mount, Margaret pursues the truth. As a woman, she is not allowed to testify in court unless her husband is present. It is the story of one woman's courage to stand against injustice even when those she loves may be implicated. She has to decide where her own loyalties lie.

The thawing of the Kennebec River at the end symbolizes the release of long held secrets, the potential for renewal and change and it serves as a reminder of the power of nature and the forces that are beyond human control.

The themes of the novel are justice, resilience and the power of truth. The novel examines the challenges faced by those who dare to confront power and prejudice, especially women in 1789.

IT WAS A ROUGH DAY. My dad, my girlfriend and I were visiting Zeyda at Moss Rehab as he was trying to bounce back from his latest challenge in order to go home. He didn't want to be there, neither did we. He didn't want to do PT but did the bare minimum so he could get back in bed. The dementia caused him to not be confident in a lot of the questions being asked of him, but one of either the doctors/PTs asked him if he liked sports: "I like football" he answered passionately. The follow up "Eagles fan?", he nodded. There were plenty of layers to Zeyda, and sports was one of those layers.

As many of you know, my Zeyda passed on May 9. He was a great man with a huge heart and I'm sure he cared for so many of you. I could talk about all of the memories for paragraphs but with this being sports-focused, I'll talk about Zeyda's relationship with sports. He took my sister and I to one of the last games at Veterans Stadium, a legendary park at the time. He went to the Eagles game very quickly off of a heart procedure in 2017, it made my parents nervous that he was there. Of course, the game was a tight one, probably not the game Zeyda needed at the time, but one that resulted with Jake Elliott hitting a 61

yard game winning field goal as time expired to beat the Giants. I came home for the Super Bowl in February 2018 to watch the Eagles win their first Super Bowl in franchise history, Zeyda of course was there. Then, we got one more in Zeyda's last year of life, for him to deservingly go out on top.

Baseball was second, with the Phillies seemingly always on if not for the news. He also took us to the race track, taught Allie and I how to gamble on the ponies at probably much too young an age. What else are you going to do to kill 3 hours with restless pre-teens in the heat of summer?? We tried to get Zeyda into golf. He was a man of many talents and abilities, but that was one he really didn't have the interest in. In the back of my head when I turned it on in front of him, I felt like there would be some sly comment coming shortly thereafter.

Zeyda had the perfect relationship with sports, and maybe it's because of all of the things he had been through in life. He passionately cared, but also when the game was over, he didn't let his feelings affect the rest of his day. He rooted and then he moved on...a relationship with sports that I certainly haven't mastered in 28 years of life. It is something that I will keep in mind as I watch a game from here on out. Zeyda, I miss you and love you everyday.

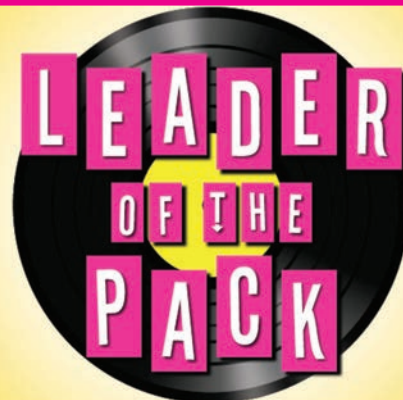

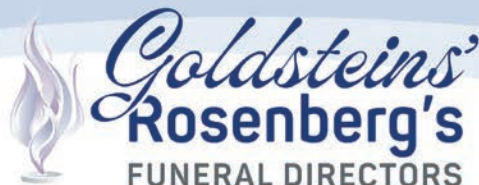

THE EMPTY NEST ■ ALLEN BORNSTEIN

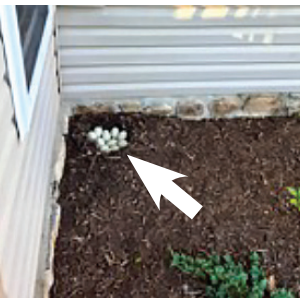
WHEN I RETURNED FROM a recent vacation on April 29th, to my surprise, I opened my front door, stepping out and frightened a Mallard female duck to my left in the flower bed of my home. I then noticed a nest in the corner of my home with 11 eggs nestled in it. I researched the incubation period of mallard eggs and found it is approximately 25–30 days, although it can vary slightly depending on environmental factors.

Mallory, the mother duck, as of Friday, May 23 had spent 26 or so days nestled in the corner of my mulched flower bed, patiently warming her 11 eggs. The days had stretched on, as I checked several times during the days of the colder and raining weather we had, each new day bringing the promise of new life. She had carefully turned each egg, whispering soft quacks of encouragement, dreaming of the moment her ducklings would break free from their shells. But the warmth of motherhood came with hunger and Mallory, the mother duck would leave at night and sometimes during the days to nourish herself with water and food to return and sit for hours on the eggs. However, when I returned home from

the gym on Friday, May 23rd, early morning, Mallory was in my driveway pacing back and forth, she flew away as I approached in my car. I thought the eggs had started to hatch into the ducklings. I walked over to the nest, to my surprise, all 11 eggs were gone, the nest was empty!



I noticed small indentations in the mulch near the nest. It told the tale of a thief in the night. I surmised who had come, a Fox. Silent. Clever. Ruthless.

A little later that morning I noticed Mallory the female duck and her male mate pacing up and down in the back area of the homes, it appeared they were looking for the eggs and/or maybe the ducklings.

They searched the area, nudging at the dirt, hoping—praying—that she'd missed something.

But there was nothing.

The world felt cruel, indifferent to the care she had poured into those fragile shells. Perhaps this wasn't the end. Perhaps nature would find a way to right its wrongs.

For even in the darkest moments, hope lingered.

Would she find her lost eggs? Or had the Fox truly stolen her dreams forever?

Only time would tell.


