TRASH BIN LOCATIONS

All trash bins and containers must be stored in the garage except on the day of collection. Trash and recycling containers should not be placed at the curb until dusk or after 6 PM on the night before collections and taken into the garage by the end of the day of collection. Trash cans and recycle bins must be placed at the curb and not on the grass areas. To minimize trash spillage and/or attraction of animals and pests, trash must be placed at the curb in the containers provided by the refuse company and not in individual bags or cardboard boxes.

We know a lot of residents violate the above rule. The VFP Board does not want to become "trash monitors"! However, continuing observances of people bringing their trash containers out

an entire day early, no matter what your reason is, or not using your containers will force a more aggressive enforcement.

CLUBHOUSE/POOL SUMMER ENTRANCE FEES

Effective Friday, May 22, 2026, a \$5 guest fee will be reinstated for guests of residents utilizing the outdoor pool, spa area, or indoor pool. The only exception is that single residents may bring one adult guest per day at no cost.

Payment Instructions:

A locked collection box is located near the entrances to both the outdoor and indoor pools. Please submit \$5 cash for each guest by attaching the payment to a completed guest slip using a paper clip before depositing it into the collection box. Guest slips, pens, and paper clips are provided in a container attached to the collection box.

Guest Pass Booklets:

Guest pass booklets containing 10 passes are available for purchase at a price of \$50 per booklet. Payments must be made by check payable to *The Villas at Five Ponds Association*. Each guest pass includes space for the resident's name and guest's name, which must be filled out prior to placing the pass in the collection box.

Booklet Purchase Locations:

- Booklets can be purchased from the property manager.
- Limited quantities may be available in the clubhouse; please enquire with a Board member.
- In all cases, payment must be made by check payable to *The Villas at Five Ponds Association*.

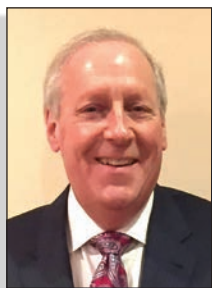

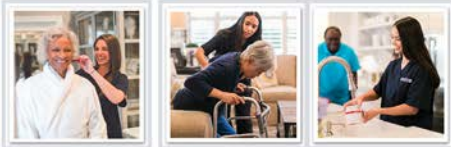

STUART SCOTT: BOOYAH IS A MUST WATCH

AS I WRITE THIS, the Flyers hold a commanding lead in the first round of the NHL playoffs, the 76ers are all knotted up against the Celtics and the Phillies are in a freefall. I'm not sure what will change when this comes out, so I'm going to switch it up and talk about an incredible documentary that I watched last weekend.

"Booyah" is an ESPN 30 for 30 film about the life of the legendary sports anchor, Stuart Scott. Stuart Scott was one of the anchors of Sportscenter in the early 2000s and truly a mainstay in the Samson household growing up as I got ready for school wanting to watch the sports highlights from last night's games. However, his journey to getting there was extremely unique and I truly don't want to give away any spoilers. A large storyline of the documentary is how he combined the hip-hop culture of the late 90s-early 2000s into his recaps and analyses, and connected with not only the Black viewer, but players, and "Booyah" and "As cool as the other side of the pillow" were catchphrases, just to name a few.



After a legendary career bouncing around almost every show under the ESPN umbrella, Scott tragically passed in 2015 after a lengthy battle with cancer. He gave one of the all-time speeches at the ESPY awards right before his passing, which they show in full length towards the end of the documentary. His legacy has lived on through many of the other black sports anchors and analysts that are on many of the sports networks today. It's an hour and 15 minutes, and you can watch this via the ESPN app or can rent it via Amazon Prime Video for \$1.99. I promise, it is worth your two bucks and your time!

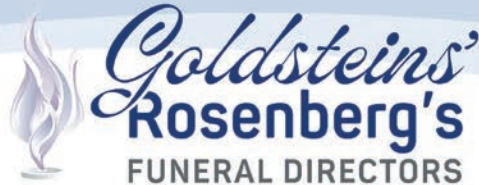
