### SIGNS & KINDS

AS WE APPROACH a major election in our country, a member of our Board suggested that we remind all of our residents of our HOA rules regarding "political, signs, events and meetings." (see below)

a. No sign, banner, flag, billboard, political sign, or advertisement of any kind, including, without limitation, informational signs, "for sale" or "for rent" signs and those of Realtors, contractors and subcontractors, shall be erected on the Property without the prior written consent of the Board. If permission is granted to any Owner to erect a sign within the Unit, the Board reserves the right to restrict the size, shape, color, lettering, height, material and location of the sign, or in the alternative, provide the Owner with a sign to be used for such purposes. Alarm Company signs are permitted in the mulch areas.

f. No political events are permitted in the Multipurpose room, and no political meetings or seminars of any sort will be permitted in any area of the Clubhouse. Religious meetings, classes, or seminars, except for educational purposes, are prohibited in the Clubhouse.

### POOL & SPA SEASON

The outdoor pool and SPA is scheduled to close on Monday, September 16th. This will give our community two full weeks after the Labor Day weekend to enjoy our outdoor facilities. The outdoor tables and chairs will remain out a little while longer for your enjoyment as well.

### POOL PASSES & GUESTS

Traditionally, The Villas at Five Ponds Board has not required guest passes or fees for use of the indoor pool when the outdoor pool is closed. This year that means from Monday, September 16th, 2024, through Friday, May 23rd, 2025, guest fees and passes will not be required for use of the indoor pool.

However, as always, a resident must accompany all guests when using any VFP facility, which includes the indoor pool. As a reminder, guests are not allowed use of our Fitness Center at any time.

### COMMUNITY E-BLASTS

Our Community E-Blasts, "Genuine VFP E-Blasts" with community information are currently being sent out by Continental Management. They are sent to all those who have registered.

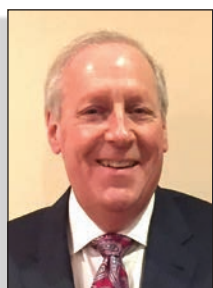

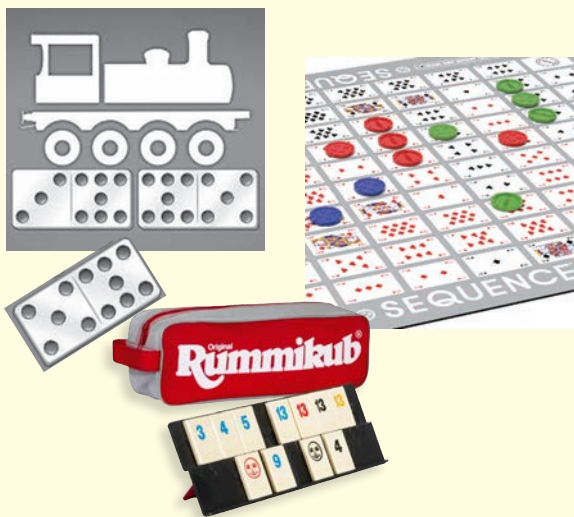

RUTH IS A TYPE A, forty something journalist from the Midwest. She meets Hal, a lawyer who is currently married, at a Legal Aid awards dinner where she is on assignment. He is the father of two teenage sons. He eventually divorces his bi-polar wife and marries Ruth. She desperately wants to have children but her eggs are "geriatric". He has already experienced fatherhood, but he wants to make Ruth happy so they embark on a journey to have a child using a surrogate. They find Cally, a nineteen-year old, on craigslist. She needs the cash to continue her college education. They have her thoroughly vetted. She signs an agreement drawn up by Hal who is a real estate lawyer. This is not his area of expertise and he will come to regret it later.

Ruth monitors Cally very closely. She accompanies her on her doctor's visits and is her Lamaze partner. She is present in the delivery room when Cally gives birth.

When Cally holds the baby, she has second thoughts. After one day in the hospital she has a change of heart. She decides she wants to spend some more time with the baby. She enlists her on again-off again boyfriend to help her escape the hospital through an open window in the midst of a snowstorm.

Once Ruth finds out the baby and Cally are gone, she embarks on a mission to find them with the help of her brother, Raymond who is a detective.

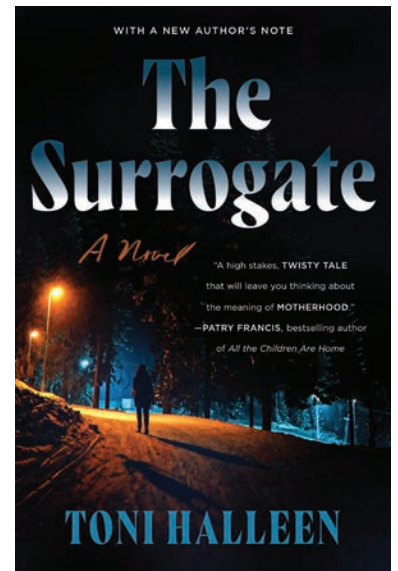

FOR MANY YEARS I would travel to the New Jersey shore areas of Ventnor, Margate, and Longport to run on the Boardwalk in the early morning with friends and to play in the ocean and beaches of those areas later in the days.

I would always look forward to stopping on the way home at a roadside produce stand to buy fresh fruits and my favorites, Jersey Tomatoes. However, over the years living here at the Villas of Five Ponds, I no longer make the two plus hour trips to the shore areas and walk only three minutes to our Clubhouse to enjoy our pool, spa, and the comradery that it offers. I do miss the Jersey Tomatoes.

However, one of our neighbors mentioned he was going to the Margate shore area, and I asked him if he would be kind enough, to stop at a roadside stand and obtain some Jersey Tomatoes for me. Well, being the good, kind, and thoughtful, neighbor/friend, Mitch, did remember my request and brought me three lovely red Jersey Tomatoes this past weekend. I ate one the morning I received



the red gems. Yum, Yum, so delicious.

When it comes to tomatoes, few varieties evoke the same level of admiration and affection as the Jersey tomato. Renowned for its rich flavor, robust texture a true American fruit it captures my heart and taste buds. What sets the Jersey tomato apart from its counterparts is its exceptional flavor profile. They are known for their perfect balance of sweetness and acidity. Their flesh is firm and meaty. The rich, deep red color of the Jersey tomato is a testament to its high levels of lycopene, a powerful antioxidant.

Remember not to refrigerate these tomatoes, eat them when you bring them home in just a few days, to enjoy this wonderful, delicious treat!

Most of the tomatoes we obtain in the local supermarkets are hot house grown, gassed to merely turn red, not ripen, and refrigerated to have a longer shelf life. If you are lucky to have a friend that grows their own tomatoes in a garden, such as a Big Boy, Beefsteak, or Heirloom, they too are tasty types of tomatoes. Again, do not refrigerate, eat when fresh picked, within a few days.

Enjoy the Jersey tomato and other fruits of the summer. Fall and Winter are around the corner.

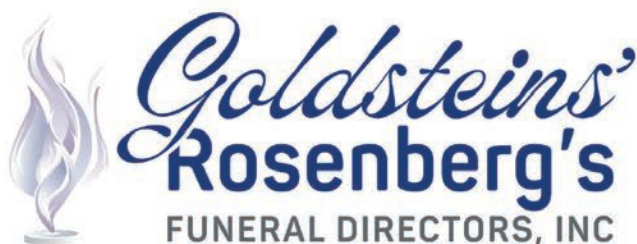
