The requirement for a **\$5. per person Guest Fee**, cash with a note or a guest pass will return for use by residents for a guest(s) for use of both our indoor and outdoor pool facilities when the outdoor pool re-opens in late May. (Date TBD)

ROOF REPLACEMENTS

Approximately, 2 to 5 weeks prior to your home/building having the shingles replaced you will receive via e-mail, if the Association has one on file for you and shortly thereafter a postal mailing, including some important documents regarding shingle replace-

ment. Upon receipt of those documents there is an action required by the owner (s). That is to sign Exhibit C, acknowledging the owners' possible responsibilities as listed in Exhibit B which is also included in the mailing. Note: Exhibit B was previously gone over at the November community roof meeting, it's been e-blasted, it's on the Villas at Five Ponds website it is on page 15 of the March 2025 Villa Voice and copies of both Exhibit B & C are on the front desk of the clubhouse.

The signed copy of Exhibit C can be doc-u- signed back to Lemus, e-mailed back to Lemus at info@lemusconstruction.com or postal mailed back to them; at Lemus Construction, 680 Sycamore Drive, Warminster, PA 18974.

Failure to provide Lemus Construction a signed acknowledgment form may result in the delay, or temporary skipping of your entire building's roof replacement. Duplicate copies of the required form can be found on the Clubhouse desk, The Villas at Five Ponds Website, <https://thevillasatfiveponds.org> or upon request of a Lemus representative on site.

If you have any questions about the shingle replacement project, please contact any member of the Board, they will give you the answer or get you an answer to your question(s).

SIDING REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT DURING REROOFING

(As per Lemus Construction note, 3-17-25) "As part of the roof replacement, certain areas of siding will need to be temporarily removed to properly install new step flashing and ensure a watertight seal. This is an industry best practice that helps protect the long-term integrity of the new roof system and prevents future leaks.

Additionally, the installation of ice and water shield is a mandatory requirement for the GAF Golden Pledge Warranty standards. We discussed this process during the Homeowner Open Meeting on November 14, 2024. It is important to note that during this process, some incidental damage to the existing Tyvek or siding may occur. This is why we included a carpentry/repair line item in the project scope. While this provision primarily covers pre-existing deteriorated siding, Lemus Construction will also replace
