

HOW?

Q What is 'The SDG Challenge'? A TSDGC is a three month Summer contest (open to all students 13 yrs +) where creative young minds are put to task to tackle three global SDGs starting Ramadan with #2 No Hunger. Must I sign up for all three or can I pick and choose? A You can choose one, two, or all three. It's up to you! What special skills do I need? What will I learn? A Aspiring youth will undertake research, hone soft skills such as problem solving and critical thinking, teamwork, presentations, presentation! O How long is each Challenge? A Each runs 2 weeks! Plus The day Briefing to Judges & Audience will be in mid-late June in which Teams will recommend ideas toward a solution. Will anyone help us? A Limited mentoring will be avail Who is eligible to participate? A Any student in UAE How many mates are allowed per team? A Up to 6 per How many teams can participate? A No limit to number of teams, yet only the top 10 will be invited to present their solutions, all others will be invited to attend/observe the Briefing in June How long do we have to present? A 10 minutes + 10 minutes Q&A by Audience and Panel of Dignitaries Is there a deadline to register? A Yes, May 30 for SDG2

Q What areas of SDG2 that teams must help to solve?
A Teams must research SDG2! A few areas include Food security, Nutrition, Resilient or Sustainable agriculture, Rural farming, Avoiding food waste, Food research, more!
Q When and where will we present our ideas, solutions?
A You will present in Dubai.

Q Will you provide transportation to the event? A No Q Can more than one team per school participate? A Yes! Q Can my team come from different schools? A Yes! Q Why should I join a team and undertake the Challenge? What will I gain? A The Challenge will provide invaluable experience (incl. **participation in 'good works').** You will master deadline based creative problem solving, working group diversity, teamwork, and enhanced presentation skills. And, **the Challenge is great for your CV - Universities and employers value such extracurricular experiences.** Q Are there gender or language requirements? A No. All are welcome to apply although a strong level of English proficiency is required by at least one team member who can serve as the leader and presenter. Q Is there a cost for participation? A No. But the Gov't venue MAX charge AED 50. Wa're working on this appl

In order to hold MUN meetings, delegates utilize diplomatic language and learn the U.N. Rules & Procedures to ensure debates are held in an organized fashion and promote fair participation.
