Annual Meeting




TSL HOA Bylaws & Declarations Being Updated

During the last few years the Board has shared its goal of updating TSL HOA Bylaws and Restrictions/Delcarations. Those we govern by today were created 25 years ago and do not reflect or support the current state of our community. We've attempted to involve community members in the process, offering them an opportunity to share their ideas. Although we did receive a handful of volunteers, most needed to step away due to scheduling conflicts. Unfortunately, more than a year later and we are still far from achieving this.

The Board is once again seeking volunteers to help with this very important project. We are looking for three to five HOA members who can provide diverse perspectives and ideas, and best represent the TSL community. The group will attend a "kickoff meeting" on Saturday, April 26th at 9:30am (location TBD) to develop a plan and schedule. If you are interested in participating, please email us.



Canada Geese Cotinue to be a Nuisance to TSL



Do Not Feed the Geese!

As the Board has requested previously, please DO NOT FEED THE GEESE. Artificial feeding can habitate them.



Roughly 80 years ago Canada geese were nearly extinct in Michigan - today they number around 300,000. Twin Sun Lakes, as its name implies, is surrounded by water sources and large, grassy areas - two features Canada geese are extremely attracted to.

The Board is aware of state's Canada Goose Program and the changes that went into effect this year in response to increased disease HPAI (Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza) concerns (for more information visit www.michigan.gov/dnr). The directs landowners first use alternative methods to address the problem. Additionally, this method would only apply to those who have established nests and would not necessarily discourage others from returning to the area

- Q: How much is the special assessment?
- The special assessment is estimated to be \$400-\$500 per TSL property.
- Q: How much is the new play structure going to cost?
- Please see the breakdown provided. This does not include replacing the ground cover.

Q: Is any of the cost being covered by the HOA savings?

Yes. The Board estimates that about \$5,000-\$10,000 will pulled from account to contribute toward the purchase of the new equipment and to pay for the clean-up and replacement of the current ground cover.

Q: Is there anything we can do to save money?

Yes. If we are able to assemble a group of volunteers to help with the removal and replacement of the mulch around and under the structure we would not need to hire a landscaper.

nt play structure is unfortunately showing its age. The coating is falling away and some of the plastic is cracking. We have been researching the possibility of replacing the current structure. Unfortunately, to do so will be quite expensive with costs ranging from \$30k to \$35k. This exceeds the HOAs current savings and would impact our ability to cover basic maintenance expenses. In hopes of alleviating some of the cost we have been looking into grants, loans, etc. with no success. As a last resort the Board is requesting a vote to allow for a special assessment. The details for the vote are available in the section to the left and on the included ballot form. Please review it carefully and send in your form with your annual dues payment.
