TIPS FOR COMPLETING 2018 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

- 1. Each application is judged on its own merit so include any information that will make you an exceptional candidate to receive the scholarship award.
- 2. Start early and take your time when completing the application. All information must be legible.
- 3. Give yourself enough time to request all of the necessary materials, especially recommendations and transcripts. Ensure that materials are properly marked and specifically identify you as a scholarship candidate.
- 4. You should have your essay and resume proofread and spell-checked for accuracy.
- 5. Review application in its entirety. If a field is left blank, it could count against you. If you do not want to answer a question, put a reason in the field or (DNA) does not apply.
- 6. Submit all information together.
