- Must submit letter of admission from the college or university.
- Must submit resume.
- Must submit a current photo. (i.e., high school senior or business attire picture)
- Must participate in an interview with the scholarship committee, if requested.
- All applications must be postmarked no later than **April 15**, **2022**.
- Scholarship recipients may only receive the Annette Walker Memorial Scholarship one time and must provide enrollment verification by July 31, 2022 or forfeit their scholarship award.

- 4. You should have your essay and resume proofread and spell-checked for accuracy.
- 5. Review application in its entirety. If a field is left blank, it could count against you. If you do not want to answer a question, put a reason in the field or (DNA) does not apply.
- 6. Submit all information together.
