



Equistar Horse Shows LLC

Class Fees are as follows:

\$8.00Per class for all classes.

\$15.00 Administration Fee - Per day, per horse/rider combination. (Required)

\$5.00 Exhibition/Warm-Up (if not showing in classes) Green horses are welcome.

\$10.00 Schooling Fee - All Exhibitors except those in classes 1-3. (If not judged & pinned) Green horses are welcome.

\$35 * Optional Nomination Fee (not required) SEE BELOW

Attire: No tube tops, tank tops or, spaghetti strap shirts will be permitted under any circumstances while showing (including exhibition). Proper attire consists of the following:

Hunter/Jumper Classes: Properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag is required for all classes. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Polos are permitted in all classes, breeches/jodphurs and appropriate English boots. Horse must be using English tack. No Hackamore's permitted. Bits deemed necessary for the safety of the rider will be permitted providing they are not deemed to be cruel or hurtful by the judge.

Western Ranch Classes: All riders under age 18 must wear protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Ranch attire is casual western: long sleeved western shirts, jeans etc. (Little to no "bling" please.)

Leadline Classes: Rider must be in proper attire as stated above. Handler/walker must have on boots. Horse must be using English tack for English classes and Western tack for western classes. Judges may penalize contestants who do not conform at their discretion.

Any Leadline participant must be able to sit in the saddle on their own, feet must be in the stirrups, (English stirrups can be wrapped) and the rider must hold the reins. Helmets are required.

The only classes where it is permissible to lead a horse is Leadline, Ground Handling, or in some games. If a horse is lead around the ring (with or without lead) in any other classes by anyone, then that horse & rider will be disqualified from that class and not eligible for points.

* Year-end awards will be awarded at an end of season event. Class/Division awards may vary based on participation within those classes/divisions. Only nominees who paid the one-time nomination fee of \$35 qualify for year-end awards and they must show in at least 4 shows in the same division to qualify. Year-End Prize list for Hunter/Jumper and Western Ranch are as follows: Year End Awards to be given for all Divisions and all Single Classes Not Included in a Division:

"Grand Champion" "Reserve Champion"

Some special awards may be given at the discretion of the show management.

In all classes points will go to the rider.

NOTE: We want everyone, competitors and spectators alike to have an enjoyable and safe day. Any riders or horses exhibiting unsafe or dangerous behavior may be warned or asked to leave the area.
