

**Mutt and Jeff:** Add up your gross score on all par 3 holes and par 5 holes. Subtract 1/2 of your course handicap for net score.

**Odd Numbered Holes:** Each player adds gross score on odd holes only. Subtract 1/2 of course handicap for net score.

**O.N.E.S:** Total score on holes 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 16, 17, 18 minus 1/2 of your course handicap for net score.

**Putts:** Count only your putts. Lowest score wins. Putts only count from the putting green surface.

**Red Hawk Points:** Each player's course handicap is subtracted from 46. The difference is each player's point's quota. Prizes are awarded for the most points in excess of each player's point's quota. Points are earned as follows: Double Bogey=1 point; Bogey=2 points; Par=4 points; Birdie=6 points; Eagle=8 points. Each player is to record her gross score and points per hole and then tally points.



**S and T's (aka Salt and Tequila):** Stroke play. Use total score of holes beginning with letters "S" or "T" (2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 12, 13, 16, and 17). Subtract 1/2 of your course handicap for net score.

**Scramble:** Each player tees off on each hole. The best of the tee shots is selected and all players play their second shots from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, then all play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.

**Select Nine:** Before starting play, circle in ink any 9 holes of your choice on your score card. After play, add up the 9 holes you chose and subtract 1/2 of your course handicap.

**Surprise Nine:** After play, the FRONT or BACK NINE will be chosen, and then 1/2 of your course handicap will be subtracted.
