

Exemplification of Charity, Unity and Fraternity







On behalf of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, I would like to express our appreciation to KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS REGINA MUNDI #4052 for your long-standing participation in the Adopt-A-Highway Program. According to our records, KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS REGINA MUNDI #4052 has been active in the program since March 15, 2010. To recognize your long-term commitment to the program, special recognition signs will be ordered and mounted beneath the Adopt-A-Highway signs on your adopted section of roadway.

Recently, a new website has been created to provide groups on-line access to the AAH program, which can be found here: <u>https://adoptahighway.penndot.gov/</u>.

These improvements will enable groups to:

- · Apply on-line,
- Use an interactive map to 'point and click to select their roadway,
- Request supplies for an event,
- Enter Trash Collections,
- Notify PennDOT after the event that bags are ready for pick-up,
- · Update their group information (contact, phone number, e-mail address),
- Renew or Cancel their agreement; and
- Communicate via e-mail (Contact your AAH coordinator to provide an e-mail address).

These improvements will make volunteer participation less time-intensive and much easier!


