THE LAST DAY FOR VOTER REGISTRATION, OTHER THAN IN PERSON, IS: **MONDAY, JULY 20, 2026.**

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their respective City or Township Clerk's office with contact information listed below. Voters need to contact respective City or Township Clerk to ascertain hours of availability. Contact Information as listed below is also posted at the respective City or Township Hall.

County of Arenac Proposal #1

RENEWAL OF E-911 CENTRAL DISPATCH MILLAGE

Shall the County of Arenac renew its tax levy of 1.35 mills (being \$1.35 for every \$1,000.00 of Taxable Value) upon all real and personal taxable property in the County of Arenac, Michigan, under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, for a period of four (4) years; being 2027 through 2030 inclusive, for the purpose of 911 call answering and dispatch within Arenac County, including facilities, equipment and operations? If approved and levied, the estimated amount of revenue for 2027 is \$1,060,578.00?

County of Arenac Proposal #2

RENEWAL OF SENIOR SERVICES MILLAGE

Shall the County of Arenac renew its levy of a tax of .75 mill, being \$.75 for every \$1,000.00 of taxable value, upon all real and personal property within the County of Arenac, Michigan, under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, for a period of six (6) years from 2027 through 2032 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for services for older persons within Arenac County, including nutritional, environmental, educational, legal, health, emotional, recreational, transportation and social needs as provided through Public Act 39 of 1976 and to include nutritional and environmental assistance to those individuals in dire (need) circumstance? If approved and levied, the estimated amount of revenue for 2027 is \$589,210.00?

County of Arenac Proposal #3

SHERIFF ROAD PATROL MILLAGE

Shall the County of Arenac renew its levy of 1.25 mills, plus add an additional .25 mill for a total levy of 1.50 mills (being \$1.50 for every \$1,000.00 of Taxable Value), upon all real and personal property within the County of Arenac, Michigan, under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution for a period of six (6) years; 2027-2032 inclusive, for the purpose of providing a County-Wide Sherriff Department Road Patrol including the payment of wages and benefits to officers, vehicle purchases, and operational expenses incurred including but not limited to repair and maintenance? If approved and levied, the estimated amount of revenue for 2027 is \$1,178,420.89.

ARENAC TOWNSHIP PROPOSALS

Arenac Township Proposal #1 Fire Millage Renewal

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in the Township of Arenac, County of Arenac, State of Michigan, for all purposes be increased as provided by Section 6, Article IX, of the Constitution of the State of Michigan by adoption of Fire Service of up to One (1) mill being One Dollar (\$1.00) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the taxable value on all property in the Township of Arenac for a period of four years (2026-2029 inclusive), for the purpose of fire service. The first year of said levy will raise an approximate amount of \$38,498.46

Arenac Township Proposal #2 Road Millage Renewal

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in the Township of Arenac, County of Arenac, State of Michigan, for all purposes be increased as provided by Section 6, Article IX, of the Constitution of the State of Michigan by adoption of Road Millage of up to One (1) mill being One Dollar (\$1.00) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the taxable value on all property in the Township of Arenac for a period of four years (2026-2029 inclusive), for the purpose of maintaining and repairing of township local roads. The first year of said levy will raise an approximate amount of \$38,498.46.

AU GRES TOWNSHIP PROPOSALS

Au Gres Township Proposal #1 ROAD IMPROVEMENT MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Au Gres Township, Arenac County, Michigan, be increased by up to two and a half mills (\$2.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of two years (2026 to 2027 inclusive) for the purpose of road improvements in Au Gres Township? If levied, this millage would raise approximately \$166,208 in the first year.

Au Gres Township Proposal #2 MOSQUITO CONTROL AND SUPPRESSION MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Au Gres Township, Arenac County, Michigan be increased by up to one mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of two years (2026 to 2027 inclusive) for the purpose of suppression and control of the mosquitoes in Au Gres Township? If levied this millage would raise approximately \$66,481 in the first year.

Au Gres Township Proposal #3 ROAD DITCHING AND WEED SUPPRESSION MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Au Gres Township, Arenac County, Michigan, be increased by up to one mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of two years (2026 to 2027 inclusive) for the purpose of road ditching improvements in Au Gres Township? If levied, this millage would raise approximately \$66,481 in the first year.

DEEP RIVER TOWNSHIP PROPOSAL ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in the Township of Deep River, County of Arenac, State of Michigan, for all purposes, be increased as provided By Article IX Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Michigan by adoption of a Road Millage of up to One (1) mill being One Dollar (\$1.00) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of taxable value on all property in the Township of Deep River for a period of four (4) years, 2027-2030 inclusive, for the purpose of maintaining, preparing, and construction of Township local roads.

The first year of said Levy will raise approximately \$71,994.11

MOSQUITO CONTROL & SUPPRESSION MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sect. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Whitney Township, Arenac County be increased by up to 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of five years 2026 through 2030 inclusive for the purpose of suppression and control of the mosquitoes in Whitney Township; and shall the township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$100,549.00?
