## **Summer Road Work:**

Turner Township has been working hard with the Arenac County Road Commission to repair roads within the Townships.

Turner Township projects include: Townsend Rd from 65 to a 1/2 mile beyond Crawford, and Young Rd from Twining Rd north to the dead end.

Turner Township has also partnered with Whitney Township to have stretches of Mackinaw re-graveled over the next few years; beginning with Turner Rd north to the dead end.

There will also be brushing work done on a section of both Gawlic and Swatz Roads.

The Township is working hard to make the roads better. It's costly and takes time, money and cooperation with the Road Commission.
