

Planning Commission Vacancy

The Turner Township Board is currently accepting applications to fill a position on the Township Planning Commission. The appointment of the new Planning Commissioner will be made by majority vote of the Township Board. The Township Board or representatives may conduct candidate interviews on date/dates to be determined.

The basic function of the Planning Commission is to make and adopt a plan for the Township's land use and development. The Planning Commission is required to review any plats or subdivisions and make a recommendation to Township Board action. The Commission also conducts public hearings and advises the Township Board regarding establishing and amending the Township Zoning Ordinances which establish land development regulations and land development districts and zones.

Meetings are held on the 4th Thursday of the first month of each quarter at 7:00 p.m. The meetings are open to the public and held at the Township Hall. Additional Special Meetings can sometimes be scheduled.
