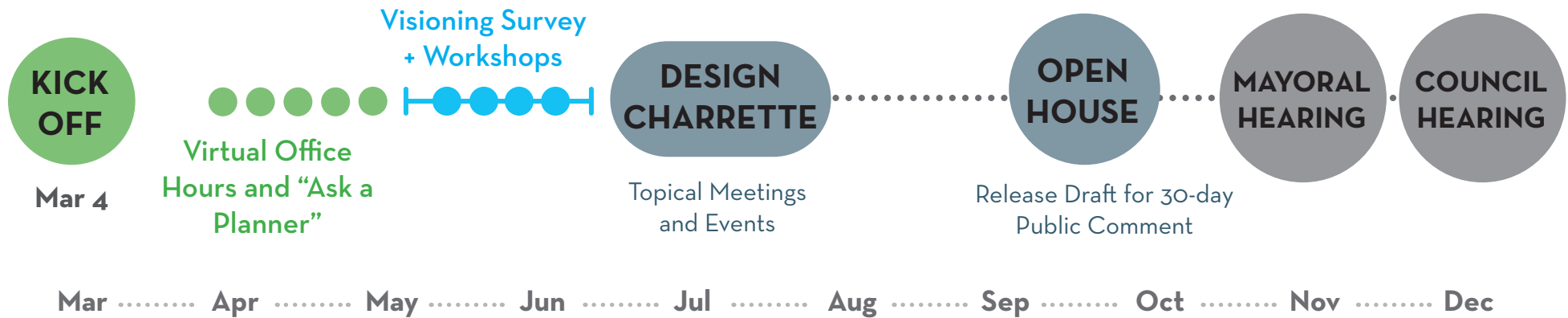


# Chevy Chase Small Area Plan Timeline

<p>Identify and convene community leaders to serve on an advisory committee to provide input on the process and plan objectives.</p> <p>Complete existing conditions data and analysis of the study area.</p> <p>Launch community engagement and begin formulating a plan vision.</p> <p>Develop plan goals that respond to key themes and elements of the vision.</p>	<p>Develop draft recommendations to achieve plan goals.</p> <p>Continue outreach to refine goals and recommendations.</p> <p>Develop a draft plan that includes vision, goals, recommendations, and implementation strategies.</p> <p>Release the draft plan for a 30-day public comment period.</p>	<p>Revise the plan based on an assessment of public comments.</p> <p>Hold Mayoral hearing</p> <p>Submit the plan and approval resolution to Council.</p>	

The Chevy Chase Small Area Plan (SAP) will, in collaboration with the neighborhood, establish a guiding vision for the area. This planning process is an opportunity for the community to envision how they see Chevy Chase contributing to a more equitable and inclusive DC for the next decade and beyond. Community discussions will focus on creating a vibrant, mixed-use gateway corridor that supports walkable retail and businesses, improving civic infrastructure, and advancing goals around housing and affordable housing.
