Genesis


Task Force:

- developed principles to guide map creation


Task Force:

- examined population characteristics at the Tract level for things like race/ethnicity and household median income



Current Ward 3 SMD boundaries




Population loci in Ward 3






Interim summary


But we had a issues to work through

- Our maps contained aspects that we didn't like.
 - There was consensus about some unappealing features of our maps
 - But there wasn't yet consensus on what had to be done
- We adhered to our process the one laid out at the beginning and kept working with our existing maps until we could reach agreement not just on the problems, but also on their causes and possible solutions
- This was the process, and it was appropriate
 - Participants could see us grappling with these problems and attempting possible solutions – as we proceeded
 - Understanding this is important


Overview of some challenges

- Chevy Chase: creating a fourth SMD and separating the Main Streets programs
- Massachusetts Avenue: unifying the Spring Valley Shopping Center and separating it from Wisconsin Avenue corridor
- Foxhall Road: reducing the size and scope of 3D
- New Mexico Tunlaw Lower Wisconsin: creating a unified and coherent treatment of the population corridor
- Middle Wisconsin: creating a new ANC


