
## My first Half-Century and beyond! A Contextual Work History

Dennis Small is the owner of a Grandma Lee's Bakery and Eating Place. He likes my enthusiasm and hires me as a baker. After two weeks of burning cinnemon rolls I'm starting to get it right.

Happily I move out of my mom's basement and find my own appartmentment.





After four month of eleven hour shifts I go on UI so I can study cartooning on my own at the Toronto Central Library.

At breakfast after work I draw




a comic I call Cavebirds. - It's good.

I get enrolled into a program at the **Information Technology Design Centre** and learn how to do design and illustration work on a computer.

I complete the program. My portfolio now includes computer generated cartoons and illustrations.

December 22 **Marie-Laure** and I get married. Next we fly to France to visit my bride's family.

1994 M&M(Markus and Marie-Laure) return from visiting family in France. ATLANTIC AVE. KINGST. M&M Meet Clive Smith Director of Nelvana Productions. I'm given tests to take home. JAN. M&M drop by at Tom Mae productions. I draw my first story board then and there for \$200. FEB. Tom Mae refers me to Carla and Russ, a couple recently engaged. They want a comic book to use as a wedding invitation. I get to work on my first comic. (23 pages) Marie-Laure talks to Terri Mulligan owner + RUSS of Baldwin Bakery. I follow up and I'm back to baking bread. MAR. TOM MAE APR. Marie-Laure finds out about The Outrider THE OUTRIBER a newspaper sold by the homeless. We go see publisher Jim Mackin who wants a weekly comic about an outer space Alien. I work it up and get published for the first time. MAY. Marie-Laure finds the Chicago comic Convention advertised in the Comics Buyers Guide, scheduled for July. As a published cartoonist I can get in free as a guest artist. We make plans to go. JUN.

Accomodations provided by our local church we make it to the **Chicago comic Convention** and it is hugely rewarding. I get to talk to some of my heroes as a fellow professional. Also **DC comics** takes me seriously and asks me to try out on one of there new books based on **Warner cartoon characters**. I get briefed on requirements and take home a script for the first three pages of a **Bugs Bunny Daffy Duck** story.

When I get home I pencil two pages of the **DC** book but I have a hard time to make it work.

Creative Carts and Freezers hire me to sell Tetley Iced Tea around Toronto.

I make sure to get noticed. M&M make the Toronto Comic Con. Marie-Laure connects with George Boyko who directs art related summer camps. He's looking for a guest artist to demonstrate sculpting techniques for six to twelve year old kids.

When we get there it turns out **M&M** are really good at teaching.

Marie-Laure finds a Janitor position in the newspaper. Free rent for part time work. M&M get to move to a really nice appartment.



Marie-Laure meets Francois Glassman at his restaurant the Saint Tropez. The man is into political commentary and he wants the cover of his menu filled with famous Canadian politicians. -All of them with a Brian Mulroney Chin.

I create a set of three Christmas greeting cards. and we sell them to neighbours in our appartment building door to door.

**Tom Mae** asks me to animate a 30 seconds cartoon for **Much Music**. He sets me up at home with a lightbox and animation paper.

1995 Marie-Laure meets the publisher of the Toronto Forum a bilingal newspaper. I draw my first bilingual comic strip. JAN. Suppose there is a bug sitting on your shoulder telling you to be mean. Marie-Laure explores government -A Meany Bug! assistance programs. With the aid Tom Mae directs of Jobs Ontario Tom Mae decides A Bad Case of the Meanies to hire me full time. FEB. And I get to do hand drawn animation. Better yet I get a whole character to myself: Professor Schlosselhofenfriesandketchup MAR. Tom Mae directs animation for Great Parks a TV nature show about Yoho National Park. I get to animate prehistoric crustations. APR. "Did you know you can put more the gas on your Irving Card?!" I animate my first TV commercial. MAY. "Nothing works out like the Lady!" After two month of working up to it I mock up a photo real animatic for a lady Speedstick cermercial. JUN. "Nothing outlasts the Lady!" A second lady **Speedstick** animatic comes off better then the first. JUL. Amway Cataloques go CD-Rom. I do inspirational sketches for it. M&M take a week off work to go swimming with wild dolphins in the Florida Keys. Tom Mae sets up for colouring AUG. animation for Marvel Action Hour ALR CAL and Gadget Boy. I'm one of a dozen people working on this. SEP. Tom Mae is going out of business. OCT. M&M hear good things about the other side of Canada. We decide to move to Victoria BC. NOV. DEC.

I move to Vancouver. 1997 I make a promotional comic for a sports store. At Kinkos I meet Frank Northcott. He is just starting a house painting and powerwashing company and we end up working together. I attend a weekly writers group lead by the beat poet Bud Osborn. I begin performing my poetry and songs at open microphone events. I attend the Search program at the Vancouver Cultural Alliance and become close friends with Eva Waldauf 1998 I attend Print to Publish a design course at SFU and the Pride Centre. My design teacher hires me to do spot illustrations for the SFU Writing and Publishing Program catalogue. The Vancouver Courier hires me to do illustrations for a short story contest. I become friends with Martin Feuchtwanger and we decide to rent a house together with some other friends. Actually Martin rents the house and I'm there to help out. At the art therapy group Creative Burst out I become 1999 friends with Laurissa Weeler and meet Dolly Hopkins for whom I make a mural for the Circus of Dreams event. I get hired at AKA Cartoon to work on storyboards for the TV show: Ed Edd'n Eddie. After four month of trying and failing I'm let go. Our home on 38th Avenue is a massive success. We have a cooking club, a chore matrix, by-weekly house meetings... -Plenty of love and support. On New Years I visit Yoga West. I make friends with Atmakar and together we do early morning yoga (Satna) 2000 beginning at four in the morning, every morning, for three month running. I try to get accepted at Emily Carr Institute of Art and Design and succeed. At Emily Carr I dream up the stories: The Reject, the Visitor and the Crossing Eva Waldauf refers me to Sandi Zweikaft an actress who wants some promotional artwork. At **Emily Carr** I complete the foundation year. 2001 I chose to major in animation. June 3 I'm struck by a car, propelled into the air, I crash land on my face. At **Emily Carr** I complete the first semester studying animation.

At **Emily Carr** the affects of the car accident are catchining up with me. Unable to meet deadlines I drop out, making arrangements to return in the fall.

At **Emily Carr** I ease back into the program with a lighter course load.

Mandana Sharifi rents a room at my home on 38th Ave. and we become lovers.

I design a business card for **Bonny Giroux**, a life drawing model at **Emily Carr**.

At **Emily Carr** I comlete the first year of animation studies.

Mandana and I break up.

I tidy up my comic *The Reject* and show the book to publishers at the **San Diego Comic Convention**.

Martin Feuchtwanger moves to a condo with his newly found life partner Cathy.
He leaves me in charge of our home on 38th Ave.

I design a business card for my friend Mark Adams

At Emily Carr I complete my second year.



I design a business card for for Alan Munro


For **Livewires** I take on Production design, Character design and animations for the game **Friend or Foe**.

With **LiveWires** I create two websites. **A Step Ahead** for client **Leon Bibb** and **Marpole** for **Joy Kogawa house.** 


We develop *Coach* to become an Exhibit at the **Richmond Central Library**

I write/draw my first children's book One very peculiar Piglet

















I self publish One very peculiar Piglet with Ingram Spark
