1 What is a peer network?

The Peer Network is a unique opportunity for CEOs and Executive Directors to hone their leadership skills to build the capacity of themselves and their organizations so that they may create new permanent supportive housing within their organizations and their communities. Participants will form a Peer Network which offers the chance for participants to draw on each other's expertise and to learn from national experts as they enrich their own skill set.

2 Peer Network Goals

- Create a Leadership Peer Network.
- Assess leadership knowledge, skills and techniques and develop a Leadership Action Plan.
- Assess the organizational readiness for developing housing project and complete capacity development plan
- Build individual and organizational capacity to lead organizations and communities to the goal of ending homelessness and increase permanent supportive housing efforts to vulnerable individuals and families.

3 Who is eligible to apply?

CEOs and Executive Directors. Senior management staff may apply with the CEO/Executive Director's approval and recommendation. More than one leader from an organization may apply. Leaders must work in organizations that are in rural areas or serve rural areas (defined as areas with less than 50,000 residents) and must plan to increase permanent supportive housing opportunities in rural areas. Please note that while the goal of this Institute is to enhance leadership skills, this is part of a larger strategy to increase permanent supportive housing for vulnerable individuals and families in rural parts of the U.S.

4 What is provided?

- An 8-month program offering specialized technical assistance, geared towards leadership and organizational readiness of the non-profit organizations in the realm of permanent housing development.
- A blend of virtual and in-person training, complete with personalized guidance and a wealth of resources to support the formulation of a community plan.
- Access to regional experts skilled in the expansion and establishment of permanent housing in rural communities.
