Opened in June, The Inn of the Patriots, 301 Cleveland Ave., is the first bed and breakfast in Grover.

Operated by Martin and Stormy Mongiello, the house was built in 1879 by Dr. Alfred Hambright, great-great-grandson of Revolutionary War Col. Frederick Hambright.

#### Rooms at the inn:

**The Baby Ruth Room** is named for the first child of President Grover Cleveland, for whom the town was named.

**The Cleveland Suite** is named for Benjamin Cleveland, who fought alongside Col. Frederick Hambright. Originally Cleveland County was spelled as the name of the suite, but was changed in 1887 to avoid confusion.

**The Magnificent Polynesian** features items collected by Mongiello during his time living in Japan. The room, along with the Oceanicus Blue Dreams Room, is painted with certified Biltmore Estate paints.

**The Oceanicus Blue Dreams Room**, located on the second floor of the inn, is painted a deep blue and is a tip of the hat to Cornelius Vanderbilt, Mongiello said.
