CITATION: For the superior performance of duty as a WWII pilot and bombardier for the United States of America crippling and inhibiting the Nazi war machine. Captain Dyer consistently performed his demanding duties in an exemplary and highly professional manner, resulting in the decision of Adolf Hitler giving up on developing the atom bomb and devoting the bulk of weapons efforts to the army, instead. Captain Dyer and many like him hit and punished the enemies of America deep in the heartland where they felt safe. In the crippling, blistering, brimstone blows of fire, bombing, flame, and blackened smoke, they reduced once-great cities to rubble.

In his later life on earth, Captain Dyer sought to help the entire human race around him. For 70 years, he has donated the education of several lifetimes shown forth to the world to many organizations, museums, associations and, societies.

At many times, he did so free of charge and at great expense to his costs, rarely ever seeking proper and adequate recompense.

Captain Dyer relates how the horrors of war have impacted families. He has a powerful effect on an audience. His exceptional abilities, personal initiative, and loyal dedication to duty reflect great credit upon himself and are recognized by the almost 50,000 alumni members of the US Presidential Service Center.
