There are 4,648 children living at or below the poverty level. This represents 19% of the child population. In 2007-2008, the Food bank distributed over 25 million pounds of food throughout our 19 county service region. In 2007-2008, the Food Bank distributed **460,347** pounds of food to agencies in *Cleveland County*. The Food Bank serves 28 agencies in Cleveland County including Upper Cleveland Area Needs, Shelby Presbyterian Church, Greater Cleveland Baptist Association, Bethany First Baptist Church, Central United Methodist Church and Crossroads Rescue Mission. The Food Bank has a branch warehouse in Dallas, North Carolina. This branch has greatly reduced time and transportation expenses for Cleveland County agencies to acquire food.

The Inn is run by a former Executive Chef to the President and First Family of the United States of America – Martin CJ Mongiello. Marti is a US Navy Retired veteran of 21 years. His wife Stormy and step-son James are trained Chefs also with Stormy having served four years herself - in the US Navy. The new Inn is a fully-functioning bed and breakfast built by the great-great, grandson of Lieutenant Colonel Frederick Hambright, Assistant Surgeon Alfred Hambright in 1879. It features silver chandeliers and 20 foot tall ceilings. They showcase the first-ever Presidential Culinary Museum with artifacts and archived materials, plates, menus and memorabilia spanning over 200 years of US history. They cook private dinners around the world, locally and for benefits to charity and corporations via, the Cooking with Chef Marti Television and Road Show.
