



Wedding Officiant Contract

This agreement is made on _____ between **Laura De Los Santos** hereafter "Officiant," and _____ and _____ hereafter "Couple," regarding the officiating of the Couple's marriage on _____ at _____.

The Couple agrees to retain the Officiant for _____. This includes a **20-30 minute** ceremony on _____ at _____ and a _____ hour rehearsal at the venue on _____ at _____ o'clock.

The wedding ceremony will include the following Unity Rituals:

The Officiant will wait up to **15 minutes** for a delayed ceremony. After that time, the Officiant **will charge an hourly rate of \$100.00**.

After the Couple has signed the marriage license, it is incumbent upon the Officiant to sign and file the marriage license with the county clerk's office no later than **10** days after the wedding.

The Couple and the Officiant may have **2** meetings in person for no more than **40 minutes** each prior to the wedding. More than **2 meetings** will result in an **additional charge at an hourly rate of \$100.00**. This time may be spent discussing the Couple's relationship, requested language, vows, and presentation.

The Officiant agrees to dress in the following manner/theme/style -

The ceremony will be conducted in English / Spanish / Bilingually.

The Officiant reserves the right to withdraw as officiant if she does not feel comfortable performing the requested ceremony, up to **30** days before the wedding.

Should the Officiant be unable to perform the wedding, she will **refund the entire payment.**

Any time, date, or location changes made for the wedding must be approved by the Officiant **10 business days** before the wedding, or else the Couple may incur a **fine/withdrawal.**

A non-refundable deposit of **\$100.00** is due at the signing of this contract to reserve wedding date. The remaining balance is due **10 days** before the wedding.

No refunds **60** days before the wedding.
