
Daily Schedule



Our classes include a balance of activities that are play based and academic. They enhance both physical and mental skills. We believe the exploration of many different activities helps in the excitement of learning.

Center Time: Children have free choice time to explore a wide range of activities around the room. There will be a variety of age appropriate toys and activities such as puzzles, blocks, sensory table, art, dramatic play, play dough, number games and other fun activities to promote fine motor skills.

Teacher Directed Activities: A teacher will bring children to the table to provide small group or one on one instruction that reflects the curriculum goals and the current weekly theme that the class is exploring.

Focus Time: The children will sit as a group at tables and work on letters, numbers, handwriting, play team activities, etc.

Gross Motor Skill Time: Being physically active is an important part of a young child's development. We will do yoga, play musical instruments, explore music, explore the outdoors.

Snack Time: Students have snack time everyday. It is not only a time for them to sit and relax and feed their bodies, it is also a time to socialize with their friends and the teacher. Each child will bring a snack from home everyday.

Circle Time: This is a large group interactive time. It includes activities such as calendar, songs, story time and theme of the week. Circle time encourages a sense of community and social interaction.

Closing Time: Students end the day together, talking about what happened during the day and what they will do in the next class.

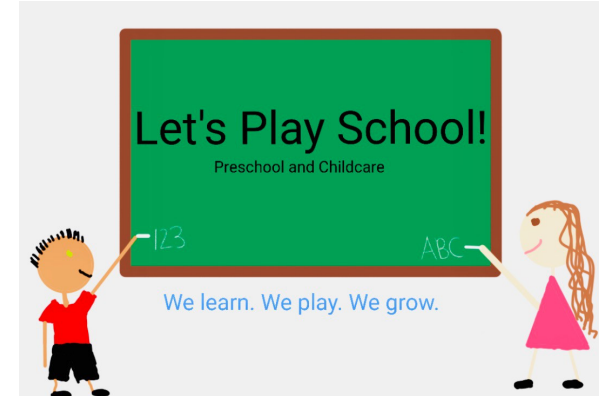

Our 2026 / 2027 Programs

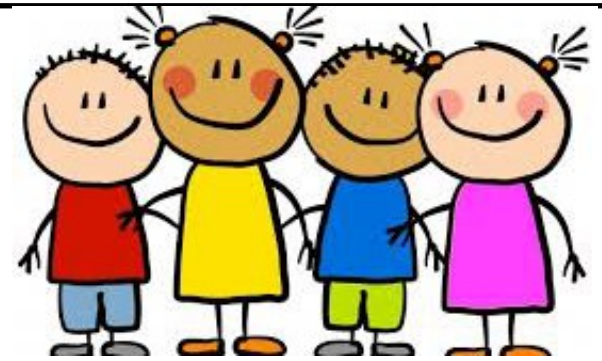
Age requirements as of September 1, 2026

Two-Day 3's: Students must be 3 years old or older. Three year olds are busy and curious. Our goal is to take this curiosity and guide them into a world of learning. This class focus's on social interaction, language development and fine and gross motor skills. This is a great class for a child's first time in a classroom. Classes meet on Tuesday and Thursdays morning from 8:30-12:30

Three-Day 4's- Student's must be 3.5 years or older. This class is for the older three year olds that are comfortable in a classroom and ready for three days. The focus of this class is social and language development and introduction to pre-reading and math concepts. Classes meet on Monday, Wednesday Friday morning from 8:30-12:30

Three-Day Pre-K- Students must be 4 years old or older. Four year old's are ready to be independent and more aware of the world around them. The Pre-K class allows children to expand skills in independent decision making, beginning reading, writing, science and math concepts. This class will prepare children for Kindergarten. Classes meet -Monday, Wednesday Friday in the morning from 8:30-12:30

5-Day Pre-K- Students must be 4 years old or older. Four year olds are ready to be independent and more aware of the world around them. The Pre-K class allows children to expand skills independent decision making, beginning reading, writing, science and math concepts. This class will prepare children for Kindergarten. Classes meet Monday - Friday 8:30 am-12:30 pm.
