

Brownfield Opportunity Area Program

The Department of State's Brownfield Opportunity Area Program provides 90:10 matching grants on a competitive basis to eligible applicants to complete Brownfield Opportunity Area (BOA) Plans (also known as Brownfield Opportunity Area Nominations) and related implementation and predevelopment activities for neighborhoods, downtowns, or other defined areas.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- (1) Planning: Development of a BOA Plan
- (2) Predevelopment Activities within a State-Designated BOA
- (3) Phase II Environmental Site Assessments within a State-Designated BOA

ELIGIBLE PREDEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

Analyses, Plans and Studies Including:

- Development of plans and specifications
- Environmental, housing, and economic studies, analyses and reports
- Building conditions studies
- Infrastructure analyses
- Renewable energy feasibility studies

Professional Services Including:

- Development and implementation of marketing strategies
- Zoning and regulatory updates
- Legal and financial services
- Real estate services
- Public outreach

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Municipalities
- Community-based not-for-profit organizations
- Joint Applications

MATCH REQUIREMENTS

- 90:10 Matching Grant
- Maximum Grant \$300,000
