

Engineering Planning Grant

ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION (EFC)

Deadline July 29th 4PM

Grants are offered to municipalities to help pay for the initial planning of wastewater infrastructure projects. The goal is to advance these water quality improvement projects to construction, so successful applicants can use the engineering report funded by the grant to seek financing through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, Water Quality Improvement Project program, or other funding entities to pursue the identified solution.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Municipalities
- MHI Eligible (less than \$75,000)

MATCH AMOUNT

- 20% Cash or In-Kind
- Other grants not eligible

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- The preparation of an engineering report
- Conducting an environmental review

FUNDING PRIORITIES

- Required by an executed United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Administrative Order, NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) Order on Consent; or
- Required by a DEC draft or final State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit (e.g. nutrient removal, inflow and infiltration, disinfection); or
- For upgrading or replacing an existing wastewater system; or
- For constructing a wastewater treatment and/or collection system for an area with failing onsite septic systems; or
- Addressing a pollutant of concern in a watershed implementation plan
