Countywide resiliency plans primarily address climate change risks and vulnerabilities associated with an increase in frequency and severity of storm and precipitation events; sealevel rise; storm surge; flooding; drought; extreme heat; and other climate hazards. Countywide resiliency plans will consider past damages, future threats, and potential economic opportunities and identify strategies and projects to make communities more resilient. It is expected these countywide resiliency plans will ensure that any reconstruction or revitalization efforts strengthen community vitality, maximize use of available funds, and reduce future weather and climate related damages.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Eligible applicants are counties, regional planning councils, or not-
- for-profits applying on behalf of a county.

MATCH REQUIREMENTS

 Up to \$2 million, with a maximum award of \$300,000 per award

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

- Reconstruction and revitalization efforts to strengthen community vitality
- Maximize use of available funds
- Reduce future weather and climate related damages
