You are a chosen people, a people belonging to God. 1 Peter 2:9



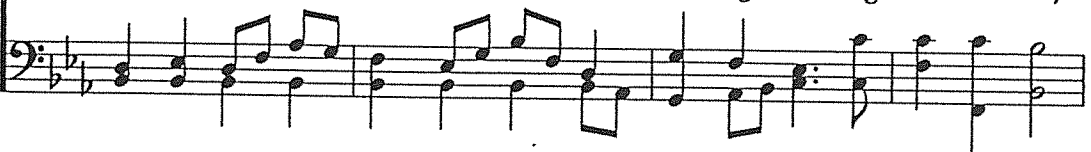
