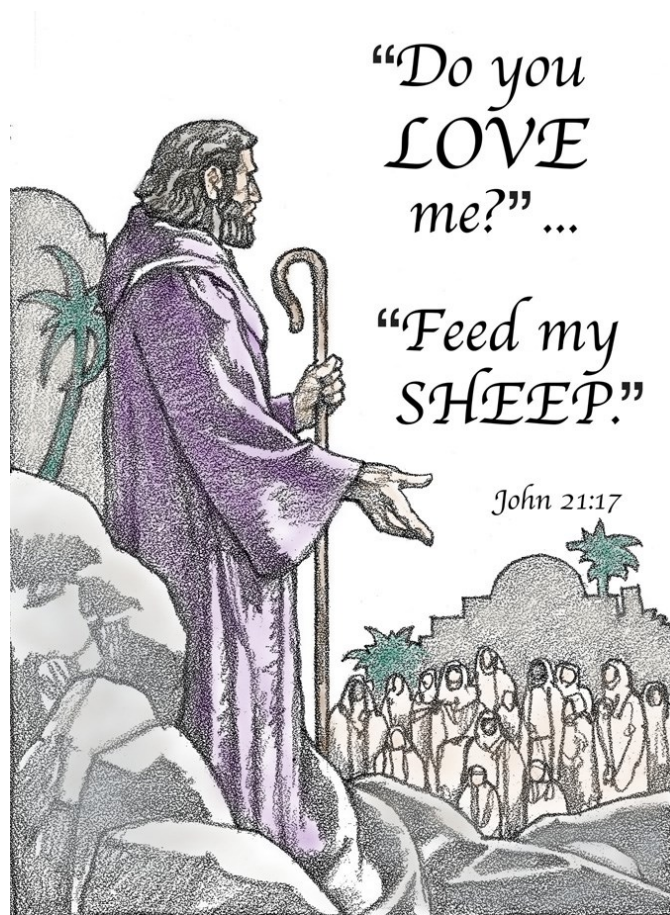

1. Peter had denied Jesus on the night Jesus was betrayed and taken away—
Peter W _____, B _____, afterwards.
2. About two or three weeks after the Resurrection, Peter and his friends have
returned to their F _____ way of life—
3. In the early light of dawn, they did not R _____ Jesus on the shore.
4. As they finished eating their breakfast — Jesus turned to Peter and asked:
“Simon son of John, do you L _____ me more than these?” T _____ times
Jesus asked, and T _____ times Peter answered: “Y _____, Lord — of
course, I L _____ you.”

B. THREE THINGS about this exchange between Jesus and Peter:

1. FIRST: in the first two questions, Jesus used the word for ‘LOVE’ in Greek
(*agape*) that means “UN _____ Love” —what God’s love is like.
Peter answered “I LOVE YOU” with the word in Greek (*phileo*) that
means “F _____ Love”
2. SECOND: the three LEVELS of Commitment to the “LAMBS” or “SHEEP”
that Jesus mentioned. The Three Levels of Duty:
1st— “Feed the lambs” — the E _____ animals to deal with;
2nd— “Take care of the sheep” — watch them, day & N _____;
3rd— “Feed my sheep” — take care of the E _____ herd. . . .

3. THIRD: Peter's positive response, "Yes, I Love you, Lord," was, in a sense, a R _____ or R _____ for Denying Jesus 3 times on the night He was betrayed.
