Jonah 3:1-5

INTRODUCTION—

I. OBADIAH— VOICE of JUDGMENT

1. We know next to N_____ about Obadiah, but his short message has a lot of P_____ : Can nations or persons live and deal UNJUSTLY and never pay a price?
2. Y'all know the saying: “What goes around, comes around”??

II. MICAH— VOICE of RIGHTEOUSNESS

1. MICAH was an ordinary guy from a poor village, but he possessed an UNCOMMON S_____ of Righteousness.
2. He called the people to REPENT: to live simple, godly Lives— he told the people: “To act justly and to love mercy and to walk H_____ with your God.” (6:8)
3. Micah tells us that the Christian Life is really very simple
4. The old hymn: “TRUST and OBEY, for there’s no other way, to be happy in JESUS— than to TRUST and OBEY.”

III. HABAKKUK— VOICE of FAITH

1. Habakkuk — was different: he wrote a prayer dialogue with God!
2. He tried to argue with God, asking God why there was no J_____ in ISRAEL
3. The GOOD NEWS in Habakkuk is that he learned to LIVE by Faith— to trust God DAILY, as he wrote in Chap. 2, Vs. 4: “But the RIGHTEOUS will live by his F_____—”

IV. JONAH— VOICE of REPENTANCE and GRACE!

Jonah has been called “the Reluctant E_____ “ —

1. God told Jonah to go and P_____ Repentance to Nineveh”
2. HE DIDN'T WANT TO DO IT!! He would rather see God's JUDGMENT fall on Nineveh!!
3. Jonah seemed like a certain P_____
5. Jonah was kind of like that smiling preacher— and he was very disappointed .
6. The MESSAGE of God to Jonah: be concerned with the THINGS that C_____ God!!
