We Welcome Our Bishop!

The Reverend Dr. Debra Wallace-Padgett was elected a Bishop of the United Methodist Church at the 2012 Southeastern Jurisdictional Conference.

At the time of

her election, she was the lead pastor of St. Luke United Methodist Church in Lexington, Kentucky – an appointment she served for eight years. During her tenure, St. Luke grew in membership, strengthened its infrastructure, built a \$4.5 million Ministry Life Center and launched a multi-cultural worship service.

Her previous service to the church includes six years as District Superintendent, three years as pastor of Paris First UMC and 11 years on staff at Lexington First UMC and two years as Director of Christian Education at Epworth UMC. She served in a variety of roles in the Kentucky Annual Conference, Southeastern Jurisdiction and General Conference. She is currently the chair of the standing Committee on Evangelism for the World Methodist Council. She previously served as a member of the Commission on a Way Forward, the General Commission on the Status and Role of Women, the Connectional Table and the Council of Bishops Executive Committee.

She is a graduate of Berea College (Bachelor of Arts in Physical Education), Scarritt College and Graduate School (Master of Arts in Christian Education), Lexington Theological Seminary (Master of Divinity) and Asbury Theological Seminary (Doctor of Ministry),

Bishop Wallace-Padgett is married to Rev. Lee Padgett, a retired deacon in the Unit-

ed Methodist Church. They are the parents of two adult children, Leanndra Thompson (Alexander) and Andrew Padgett and two granddaughters (Crindalyn Thompson and Raylena Mildred Thompson)

We Welcome Our District Superintendent!

The Rev. Sandra Johnson is a native of Chattanooga and attended the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga where she received a B.A. in sociology/social work. Before answering



her call to the ordained ministry, she was employed with BellSouth Telecommunications.

In 1995, she began her candidacy and was licensed as a local pastor in 1996. In May 2008, Johnson received a Master of Divinity degree from Gammon Theological Seminary at the Interdenominational Theological Center in Atlanta. Her prior local church appointments include Eastdale Village Community, Hurst Memorial, and Strawberry Plains United Methodist churches. In 2011, she was appointed as district superintendent in the (Abingdon, Virginia) Clinch Mountain District.

Johnson retired at the 2019 Annual Conference but served Pruitt Hill-Tate Chapel in Greeneville during retirement. At the 2023 Holston Annual Conference Johnson came out of retirement to serve as the Hiwassee District Superintendent. She is married to William Leon, and they are the parents of two children, and several grandchildren
