
First United Methodist Church

In order to rebuild the sanctuary, offices, classrooms, and additional gathering spaces of 1st UMC Madisonville, the church took out a building loan of \$900,000. These funds were combined with insurance money and other donations for the rebuild, which was finished in 2011.
