Read Together in 2024

This year Rev. Chris Black invites you to join him in participating in the Holston Conference's "Read Together" initiative. This opportunity challenges us to read through the whole Bible in one year. In 2024, we will be reading the Bible chronologically using a path laid out in J. Ellsworth Kalas's "The Grand Sweep: 365 Days from Genesis through Revelation." This reading plan asks us to read only 2-3 chapters a day which will be much less burdensome than previous years studies.

Participating in this initiative as a whole congregation can uniquely bind us together as Christ's disciples all while rooting us more deeply in God's word. There will be book marks available in the welcome center with each month's readings, and the readings for the week will also be printed in the bulletin.
