I had a special need	2%
I just walked in	3%
I like the pastor	6%
I visited there	1%
I like the Sunday School	1%
I liked the program	3%
A friend or relative invited me	79%

It becomes clear from the above survey, which is typical of other surveys across the country, that *the way people get to church is: other people invite them!* People who do not have a church home come to a church because people they know and trust—either Friends, or Relatives, or Acquaintances, or Neighbors—invite them to their church!

This means that the most effective "evangelists" in every congregation are: the current members! Each and every one of us can invite our "F.R.A.N.s" (the "Friends, or Relatives, or Acquaintances, or Neighbors" mentioned earlier) to come to First United Methodist Church of Madisonville.

We are sending letters out to new Visitors and "Guests" who worship with us each week, letting them know more about our church, and inviting them back to our wonderful congregation. There are new residents moving into our community every week—let us know if anyone moves into *your* neighborhood, and we will deliver them a fresh loaf of bread within a few days, along with information about our church and a warm invitation to our worship services. God came to us in Jesus Christ to tell us of His inviting love. Let us go to our new neighbors and invite them to a church that is full of God's love!



- Box Tops for Education –either cut the coupons from the package or scan your receipt for the new digital coupons


Flowers


