CONCLUSION—

Dear Friends,

You have heard a few disturbing reports on TV news programs, and in other media, about a potential division in the United Methodist Church in America, following the vote of the Called General Conference in St. Louis nearly one year ago. Having been in the United Methodist church all of my life (baptized at one year of age, did Confirmation in the 7th grade, made a Profession of Faith and joined the church then), I can tell you, that no decision will be made quickly! Nothing can be done without the approval, by majority vote, of the General (International) Conference, which meets regularly every 4 years. The General Conference that met last year in St. Louis was a special, Called Conference, to deal with the issues of ordination and whether to approve of same sex marriages officiated in United Methodist churches, by United Methodist clergy. The next regular General Conference will meet this May, in Minneapolis, Minn. We elected lay and clergy representatives to the 2020 General Conference last June at the Holston Conference meeting, as we do every 4 years. Methodist General Conferences have been held every 4 years since 1784. Accidentally, I think, they happen in April or May of years in which American voters elect a President in November.



There are now 5 proposals that have been, or will be, transmitted to the General Conference for discussion, and perhaps, to be voted on, at the May General Conference in Minneapolis. These proposals, and some discussions about the different views, have been published on-line on the Holston Conference news outlet, “The Call.” If you want to read those articles, log onto the Holston Conference website at ‘holston.org,’ or contact our church office and we can e-mail you that information.

Our choice, here at First United Methodist Church of Madisonville, is to continue to do God’s work in our church, to share and to live the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to teach and encourage children, youth, and people of all ages to grow in their faith in Christ, and spread His love and grace everywhere we can, in Madisonville, in Monroe County, in east Tennessee and beyond. We encourage everyone to pray for God’s guidance in these matters, and to continue to trust in God, and to spread the love of Jesus, every day.
