II. WHY DID GOD BECOME HUMAN???

A. THE NAME makes it clear —

1. **JESUS** is the New Testament Greek version of the Hebrew <u>J</u>—It means "the LORD <u>S</u>...@"

- 2. ALSO— <u>CHRIST</u> means "<u>A</u> <u>O</u> "in Greek, same as the Hebrew word <u>M</u> refers to ONE "SET APART" by GOD.
- **B.** THE "INCARNATION" Philippians 2:5-11
- C. LIFE IN "HUMAN HANDS" God Become Intimate...

Apart from Christ we know little about God. If we try to start from God, we do not start from God, but from our ideas about God. But our ideas about God are not God. We must start from God's idea about Himself, and God's idea about Himself is Christ. Jesus is God breaking through to us. He is the great simplification--God speaking to us in the only language we can understand, a human language; showing us His life in the only way we could grasp it, a human life; uncovering His character in the place where your character and mine are wrought out, a human character. 
