## A BIBLICAL PRAYER for BELIEVERS

The believers in the Philippian church meant a great deal to Paul the Apostle. They were his first converts in Eu-

rope, for he had only days earlier crossed over the Bosphorus strait from Asia Minor, and arrived in the city of Philippi. The believers in the Crucified and Risen Jesus Christ were enthusiastic disciples, and supported Paul for the duration of his ministry there. For years after he had moved on, they continued to write him and send monetary support, as well as sending their encouragement and affirmation that they were praying for him.

Paul responded in kind, when he was able to write to them. In the New Testament Letter to the Philippians, he indicated in chapter 1, verse 9, that he was praying for them, and he told them how he was praying. What he wrote to them is an ideal example of how we might pray for one another, and how we might pray for all Christians we know: "And this is my prayer, that your love may overflow more and more with knowledge and full insight to help you to determine what is best, so that in the day of Christ you may be pure and blameless, having produced the harvest of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ for the glory and praise of God."

On the third weekend of this month, March 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>, we will have a special guest with us, the Rev. Brent L. White, Senior Pastor of Toccoa United Methodist Church, in Toccoa, Georgia. He will be with us for a meal on Saturday evening and a study afterward on the Class Meeting in the days of John and Charles Wesley, and the Class Meeting for United Methodist Christians today. He will also be preaching that Sunday morning.
