INTRODUCTION—

I. GOD KNOWS US!! Romans 14: 7-9

A. PEOPLE ASK: Where did we C From?

1. One of the fundamental A of modern science is that “Everything can be explained by SCIENCE-” There are no M.”
2. This assumption includes, for *SOME* scientists, the assumption that: GOD is supposed to work Miracles- HENCE, if there are no Miracles, *there is no G*!!
3. Some people have said that ONE REASON our country’s space program exists- N.A.S.A., the National Aeronautics and Space Administration- one reason it exists is to: prove that God does not E!!
4. There is an old saying: “*FAITH seeks U*!”
5. Science does not have any certain answer of W we exist.
That is the job of religion and philosophy.
6. BUT G DOES!!!!!!
7. GOD KNOWS US, I O!!!
8. Psalm 139 says: “*For you created my inmost being*”

B. Whether we LIVE or DIE.... We belong to G!!

1. We belong to God, simply because He C Us!!
2. But- also because Jesus died to pay the P for our SINS- as the apostle Paul wrote to the Corinthians: “*You are not your own; you were bought at a price.*” (I Cor. 6:20)

3. And in II Corin. 5, he said: *“And [Christ] died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for Him...”*
4. THEREFORE: If you trust Jesus Christ as your SAVIOR, if you are a CHRISTIAN- YOU B_____TO GOD!!
5. v. 8- *“Whether we LIVE or DIE, we Belong to the LORD.”*
6. SO- LET US: Be whom GOD CALLS US TO BE!!!
