INTRODUCTION—

I. GOD CHOSE THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL

A. The Children of I _____ — Descendants of A _____.

1. Through Abraham, God was selecting a great N _____, through whom the whole earth would be blessed. (Gen. 12:1-3) When God called Abraham to go to the Promised Land, the LORD said:
“I will make you into a GREAT NATION and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing.”
2. God’s plan from the time of Abraham was: To Bless all the Peoples of the Earth— *THROUGH I _____!!!*

B. Salvation comes through the H _____ of Israel— C _____!

1. God’s Goal . . . always: Save the world— *through C _____!*
2. Jesus Christ is the FULFILLMENT of the promise to Abraham!
3. That’s the meaning of Ch. 10:4: “ *Christ is the E _____ of the Law.*”
4. And, as in Ch. 10: 12, that there is “*NO DIFFERENCE — both JEWS and GENTILES— CAN BE SAVED*”

C. Then— Did God Reject Israel??

1. “_____!!!” — Israel rejected God’s plan, God’s promise through Abraham, for the Messiah (or Savior)— JESUS!!
2. Yet God is saving a R _____— as in Elijah’s day, there is a small portion of the Israelite people who trust and obey God through the JEWISH SAVIOR, JESUS the CHRIST.
3. People like: Joseph Schereschewsky, a Lithuanian Jewish guy....

D. God’s Promise Is Still— to the Nation of Israel

1. In Ch. 11, v. 17, that Gentiles who follow Jesus are “spiritually” “Grafted

on-to” the Hebrew promise of God!!

2. In this sense, all Christians from a Non-Jewish background, become
“Jewish” when we start to follow Jesus!
