1. Rather, let the way we Live our Lives be a Minute-by-Minute  
D \_\_\_\_\_ to God!! Sacrifice . . . . to God and to *HIS* Purposes!!
  2. Worship and Praise God, not just on Sunday morning for an hour, but  
Every Day. . . .
- B. BE T \_\_\_\_\_ —
1. Should the World and selfish desires tell us what is important?!?
  2. NO!!! Instead, have G \_\_\_\_\_ Priorities—Love Jesus, Love your families,  
care for those around you, reach out to help the L \_\_\_\_\_ Fortunate . . .
- II. U \_\_\_\_\_ YOUR SPIRITUAL GIFTS!!
1. “S \_\_\_\_\_” Gifts, like Healing; speaking in Tongues and the interpretation  
of Tongues; and Miracles;
  2. “L \_\_\_\_\_” Gifts, like Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor and  
Teacher: the Gifts mentioned in Ephesians 4....
  3. and the rest as “A \_\_\_\_\_ Gifts,” to help the Church in the work of  
the Gospel.
  4. BUT—What ARE the “ASSISTING Gifts”???

2. T \_\_\_\_\_ — this refers to ANY KIND of Christian Teaching, especially Teaching the Bible . . . .
