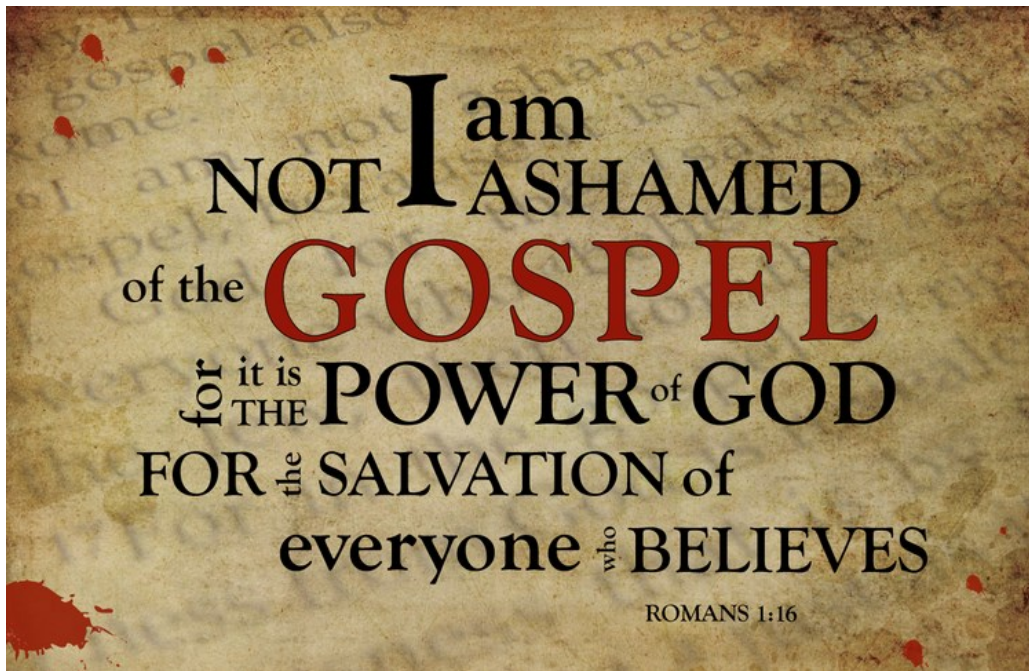

**Romans 1:11-17**

INTRODUCTION —

I. HOW ARE WE SAVED??!?!?

A. A Roman Citizen then would have said, “What do you mean, “S \_\_\_\_\_?”  
S \_\_\_\_\_ from what??” Pagan Romans didn’t BELIEVE in Salvation, or  
Eternal Life.

B. A JEWISH PERSON (then and now) WOULD SAY:

1. “We are ‘saved’; (to eternal life) by keeping the Law of M \_\_\_\_\_.

2. Many Jewish people (then and now) thought that God will judge you on the  
Day of Judgment according to how well you kept the Law of Moses. If  
your good D \_\_\_\_\_ outweigh your bad D \_\_\_\_\_, you will go to  
Heaven.

3. That is STILL a C \_\_\_\_\_ view today!

C. But: the Apostle Paul and early Christians believed differently.

As Paul explained to others: “*For it is by G \_\_\_\_\_ that you have been  
saved, through F \_\_\_\_\_— and this is not from yourselves, it is the  
G \_\_\_\_\_ of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.*” (Eph. 2:8-9)

## II. “SALVATION BY FAITH” REDISCOVERED— by Martin Luther

A. The Son of a Mine-Owner: named Martin L\_\_\_\_\_ in 1510

1. Convinced that God didn't want him to be a L\_\_\_\_\_, but instead a \_\_\_\_\_!
2. One day, as he read Romans ch. 1, he said it was as though v. 17 had been written in the sky— “The J\_\_\_\_\_ will live by Faith.” God made it clear to him: We cannot “S\_\_\_\_\_“ ourselves from sin— only J\_\_\_\_\_ Christ can do that, by our trusting and having FAITH in H\_\_\_\_\_!!

B. He began to P\_\_\_\_\_ and T\_\_\_\_\_ on our Bible text —

1. But — German churches, and many other European Christians and churches A\_\_\_\_\_ with Luther, and many new churches were started.
2. *THAT*, is how P\_\_\_\_\_ Churches— got started!! Because of 2 Bible verses: Romans 1:16-17!!

## III. WE ARE SAVED — Only through our F\_\_\_\_\_ in Christ!

A. What Paul and all the Apostles preached and taught— was REVOLUTIONARY in the First Century!!

B. It is Revolutionary today!!
