

Romans 1:11-17

INTRODUCTION —
I. HOW ARE WE SAVED??!?!?
A. A Roman Citizen then would have said, "What do you mean, "S?" S from what??" Pagan Romans didn't BELIEVE in Salvation, or Eternal Life.
B. A JEWISH PERSON (then and now) WOULD SAY:
1. "We are 'saved'; (to eternal life) by keeping the Law of M
 Many Jewish people (then and now) thought that God will judge you on the Day of Judgment according to how well you kept the Law of Moses. If your good <u>D</u> outweigh your bad <u>D</u>, you will go to Heaven.
3. That is STILL a <u>C</u> view today!
C. But: the Apostle Paul and early Christians believed differently.
As Paul explained to others: "For it is by <u>G</u> that you have been saved, through <u>F</u> — and this is not from yourselves, it is the <u>G</u> of God—not by works, so that no one can boast." (Eph. 2:8-9)

II. "SALVATION BY FAITH" REDISCOVERED—by Martin Luther
A. The Son of a Mine-Owner: named Martin L in 1510
1. Convinced that God didn't want him to be a <u>L</u> , but instead a!
 One day, as he read Romans ch. 1, he said it was as though v. 17 had been written in the sky— "The J will live by Faith." God made it clear to him: We cannot "S "ourselves from sin— only J Christ can do that, by our trusting and having FAITH in H !!
B. He began to P and T on our Bible text —
 But — German churches, and many other European Christians and churches A with Luther, and many new churches were started.
2. <u>THAT</u> , is how <u>P</u> Churches— got started!! Because of 2 Bible verses: Romans 1:16-17!!
III. WE ARE SAVED — Only through our <u>F</u> in Christ!
A. What Paul and all the Apostles preached and taught— was REVOLUTIONARY in the First Century!!
B. It is Revolutionary today!!
