Romans 5:6-11; 6:1-7
INTRODUCTION —
I. CHRIST D FOR US
A. Paul — We <u>C</u> save ourselves! Only <u>C</u> can!
1. He has said this earlier in the letter. NOW he explains why:
vv. 6-8: "for a good man one might possibly die"
2. In 1981, President Ronald Reagan
3> For a " <u>G</u> man," he was "willing to die!!"
B. BUT— What about "NORMAL" people — like you and me?
1. GOOD NEWS!! "Christ died for us!" — For ALL of us!!
2. THO' we don't deserve it— Jesus <u>T</u> Himself in the DIRECTION
of GOD'S WRATH and JUDGMENT—
II. HOW THEN SHOULD WE LIVE?? IS IT "OK" to SIN??
After all: WHAT <u>IS</u> the BASIS of Christian Morality?
A. THE ARGUMENT THEN:
1. Paul — at the end of Chap. 5 — the O. T. Law of Moses was given so that people would S with a understand what "vile & rotten sinners" they were. Romans 5:20 says: "But where sin increased, grace increased at the more" (NIV) OR — as the Contemporary English Version puts it: "Yet where sin was powerful, God's Kindness was even more powerful."
2. Some people: "If we SIN more, we'll get M of God's KINDNESS and
LOVE and FORGIVENESS!!"
2 Paul's answer: NO W

4. In other words: you don't <u>HAVE</u> to obey your former lusts, desires, fears,
ambitions, selfishness, anger, etc.!
5. DARE— to be <u>D</u> ! Different— than you <u>USED</u> to be!
6. Sin can't <u>C</u> you now! Jesus makes you FREE!
B. SO — CAN WE: "PICK & CHOOSE" OUR CHRISTIANITY?
1. PAUL'S '' ANSWER:!
2. Selected OBEDIENCE is not OBEDIENCE at all—it is
merely <u>C</u>
3. DO YOU have any "BAD HABITS??"
4. What about CONSCIOUS actions: <u>B</u> ??
DO NOT A Yourself to give into them!
DON'T EVEN GIVE those old habits a <u>C</u> !
5. Break old habits— 6: 11— Consider that "you are dead to sin" —
that it cannot control you.


