Communion is today but what is it???

The Lord's Supper, Holy Communion and the Eucharist are all names for the 2nd sacrament celebrated by United Methodists. Each of these names highlights an aspect of ministries of play, love and care by emailing this act of worship. The Lord's Supper reminds us that Jesus Christ is the host and that we participate at Christ's invitation. Jesus invites us to take part in the special meal he ate with his disciples the night before his crucifixion and other meals he shared in homes and on hillsides. Holy Communion invites us to focus on the self-giving of the Holy God which makes the sacrament an occasion of grace and on the holiness of our communion with God and one another. Finally, Eucharist, from the Greek word for thanksgiving, reminds us that the sacrament is thanksgiving to God for the gifts of creation and salvation. The pastor will lead the congregation in a prayer called "The Great Thanksgiving." We join in the ancient tradition of sacrifice by offering God our praise and thanksgiving for the wondrous gift of salvation. We offer ourselves and our gifts of bread and the fruit of the vine to God with thanksgiving. We ask for the Holy Spirit to be poured upon us and these gifts that they may become for us the body and blood of Christ, nourishing us, who have been redeemed by his blood, to be the body of Christ in the world. We conclude praising the Triune God-Father, Son and Holy Spirit-before uniting our voices in the Lord's Prayer. In the United Methodist Church we have an open table which means that all are welcome to participate in communion with us!
