EMS QRS Agencies: Harrisville VFC will be the designated QRS agency once they report that they have completed their licensure. Still waiting for PA DOH inspection.

<u>Anegada Energy</u>: Will provide Mercer Twp. with copies of all permits & will obtain a road bond prior to any work being done in the Twp.

<u>"For Love of the Lost"/Fish property</u>: Updated solicitor on property condition. Videos have been emailed to him. Junk vehicles have increased. <u>Motion</u>: to request solicitor to enforce agreement:

200 Shields Road: Developer's Extension Agreement has been signed. Escrow funds have been received. Homeowner is responsible for the total construction cost & will install per Twp. engineering direction & later turn part of the line over to the Twp (from the grinder pump to the main line). Their contractor is to provide design planning for engineering approval.

<u>Traffic on Wick Road</u>: L. Lennon speeding complaint-wants a solution to slow down traffic. J. Bennett, Jr. spoke to our engineer who advises this is an enforcement issue. There is nothing that can be done by engineering. A lower speed limit is still an enforcement issue. Installing traffic calming devices such as speed humps only creates more of a hazard for drivers and makes it more difficult to plow snow in winter. Office responded to resident with this information.

Evans to get an update on where this agreement stands so we have time to review and accept it. Agreement should be provided to us & solicitor by tonight's meeting.
