Weaver presented plans to the board explaining how Anegada Energy is planning to connect the gas well pad on Shields Rd. in Mercer Twp. to the nearby gas well on Harmony Rd. in Slippery Rock Twp. & then transport their product to a station on Glacial Till Rd in Liberty Twp, Mercer Co. Lines will bore under Twp, roads where necessary, but not run along them. They are currently working on obtaining all permits from DEP, PA & any residents whose property is involved. They are focused on keeping noise & other disruptions to a minimum for residents. They will provide Mercer Twp, with copies of all permits & will obtain a road bond prior to any work being done in the Twp. M. Schultz presented information on the Slippery Rock Community Library & thanked us for our continued support. She will provide information to be posted on our website. V. Kennedy asked questions about his sewage invoices & statements. He was given his current balance & stated that he would pay all 3 accounts up to date on Tuesday.
