BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR:

OLD BUSINESS:

Kozy Rest Sewage Expansion: Received signed agreement with Marion Township & Kozy Rest. Invoice sent to Kozy Rest for 2024 expenses. Correspondence continues with the EADS engineer as planning and implementation proceeds. Responded to the question about the flow meter location after the December meeting: Keep at Twp. line. They have again requested the flow meter to be placed at Kozy Rest and would like us to reconsider. We will use Dan Goncz, Gannett Fleming as our third party Engineer as needed. Letters have been mailed to residents informing them of the work to be done and the main line tap installation.
