- 4. Sheriff Sale (6): **Update**: Six properties had further documentation filed on 8-24-23 at the courthouse. J. Green; S. Heller; R. McFeaters; & 3 G. Kennedy properties. G. Kennedy's atty. is working with our Solicitor to negotiate a payment plan for his 3 properties.
- 5. <u>Grove City Lateral Inspection Program</u>: Received packet with Ordinance to be adopted before 1-1-24, along with their Resolution with technical details for implementation.

Private Sewer:

- 1. Pelletier property: Office sent resident a letter notifying of 30 days to comply or will be turned over to the Solicitor. Our solicitor has given us a new agreement to be signed by the property owner and the Township. Changes were made to the agreement to accommodate the SEO and the Township which will now be sent to the solicitor for confirmation. The SEO does not do maintenance, just inspections, and states that any correspondence should come directly from the Township on this issue.
- 2. On-Lot Sewage Permits: 6 permits this year 1 for DeSanti, 4 for Reich, 1 for Boozel.

- 3. <u>Building Permits</u>: 10 permits this year 4 wrecking, 1 deck, 2 additions, 1 mobile home, 2 garages. Sent correspondence to 4340 William Flynn Hwy. (Patrick Brydon) informing them they need a building permit. Patrick called on 9-11-23 and stated that he read on the website that a building permit is NOT required for any structure under 1000 square feet, and therefore he refuses to get a permit. He was informed that he DOES need a permit, but he again refused. He said to give the Supervisors his phone number.
