Butler Co. Municipal Outreach Meeting: (1-9-24) Commissioners gave a quick update: working to get prevailing wage limits raised to \$250,000/project. EMS program through BC3 will pay people to attend training and for books and education. Won't solve the crisis but is a step in the right direction. Also working on ways to get non-transport EMS calls reimbursed. Need municipalities to enact the 0.5 mill EMS tax. Cranberry Twp. recognized as 9<sup>th</sup> safest community in USA. First safest in PA. Guest speakers from the EPA gave info. on Superfund sites - hazardous waste sites that have been addressed and managed for cleanup. Bruin Lagoon (Bruin Boro) and Hranica Landfill (Buffalo Twp.) Discussed safety of consuming animals from hunting and fishing.
