#### **MERCER TOWNSHIP UPDATE**

**TOWNSHIP HOURS:** As you can see, we have posted general office hours. We are *typically* open from 11 am to 3 pm on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Appointments during these times are suggested so we can be prepared to better serve your needs. Also, if you need assistance at other times, please call to schedule an appointment.

**2024 TOWNSHIP ROAD PROJECTS**: Our road projects this year will consist of berm repair, ditch cleaning, and filling of potholes where needed. We plan to keep the berms mowed with a fall mowing of the banks/brush along the Township roadways to help provide better visibility for fall and winter driving. Paving projects have been pushed to next year, as the Township has purchased a new truck at a cost of approximately \$230,000. Funds have been allocated for the truck to be paid in full upon delivery in June.

**PERSONNEL CHANGES**: On Dec. 31st, 2023 **Rick Stuchal** retired as Township Supervisor. Rick served as a supervisor for 24 years and has made some substantial changes in the Township over the years. All Township roads are now paved roads; we have a new Township municipal building; and there is public sewage in two vital areas, Forestville and Route 58,east and west of Harrisville. Please congratulate Rick on his retirement. **Bill Long** has been elected as your new Township Supervisor. Bill is a great addition to our Board of Supervisors with much to offer. **John Bliss** is our new Township Auditor, replacing Sandy Snyder. John is a long time Forestville resident.

PUBLIC SEWER NEWS: Kozy Rest Campground will be connecting to our public sewage system on Campground Rd via a private, metered line. They are located in Marion Township and will be joining Mercer Township and Harrisville in connecting to Grove City. We have no sewage expansion plans in the works for our current system. Automatic payments using debit or credit cards have increased in popularity, and busy residents find it a very helpful tool to stay current. Our overall delinquency rate has declined thanks to folks taking advantage of the auto-pay option. Some folks still are severely delinquent, and legal progress is being made via our Solicitor to resolve these accounts. At the moment, at least 3 properties are being prepared for Sheriff sale and we have one Estate claim filed. There are currently 10 Municipal Liens filed on delinquent and/or unconnected properties.

**PRIVATE ON-LOT SEWAGE PERMITS:** Mercer Township is no longer affiliated with the Municipal Code Association. Dave Ice is our current Sewage Enforcement Officer (SEO). Applications are now processed through the Township office. Dave's initial fee is \$850 for soils (pit) up to 5, perc, final inspection and first design review. The office charges a \$25 administration fee. There may be additional fees for alternate testing. Please call the office with any questions or to schedule an appointment to complete an application.

**BUILDING PERMITS**: Since we are no longer affiliated with the Municipal Code Association, building inspections are now completed by Construction Code Inspectors, Inc. (CCI) from Seneca, PA. Any new construction, additions and/or demolitions within the Township require a building permit. All necessary forms are available on our website along with instructions. You can print the forms, complete them and call the office for an appointment. There are also applications available at the Township office. Mercer Township charges a \$25 application fee.

**EMS TAX**: Residents now pay a 0.5 mill EMS tax. This provides the following services to Mercer Township residents: *All residents of Mercer Township are covered under an ambulance agreement with Superior Ambulance Service as your provider. However, you may choose to request another service if you like. If you use Superior Ambulance Service for a 9-1-1 type call you will only be responsible for 50% of your Insurance Co-Payment for ambulance service. There is no need to purchase a membership if you live within the Township.* 

**BROADBAND**: The FCC has not yet renewed funding for the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) and funding may expire in April, 2024.
