### **BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR:**

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

<u>Kozy Rest Sewage Expansion</u>: Awaiting payment for invoice sent in December to Kozy Rest for 2024 expenses. Responded to the question about the flow meter location after the Jan. mtg.: Keep at Twp. line. We will use Dan Goncz, Gannett Fleming as our third party Engineer as needed.
